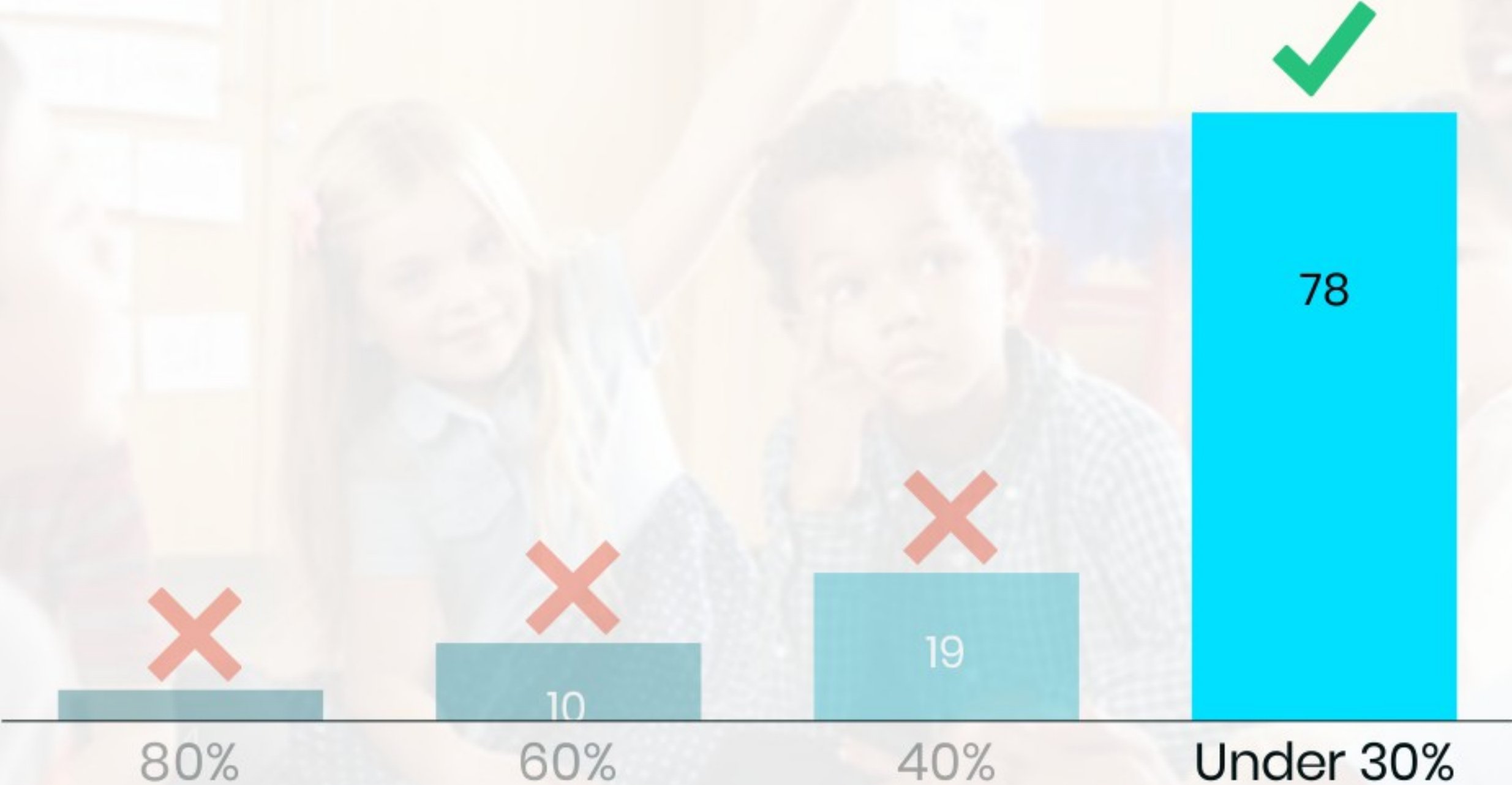

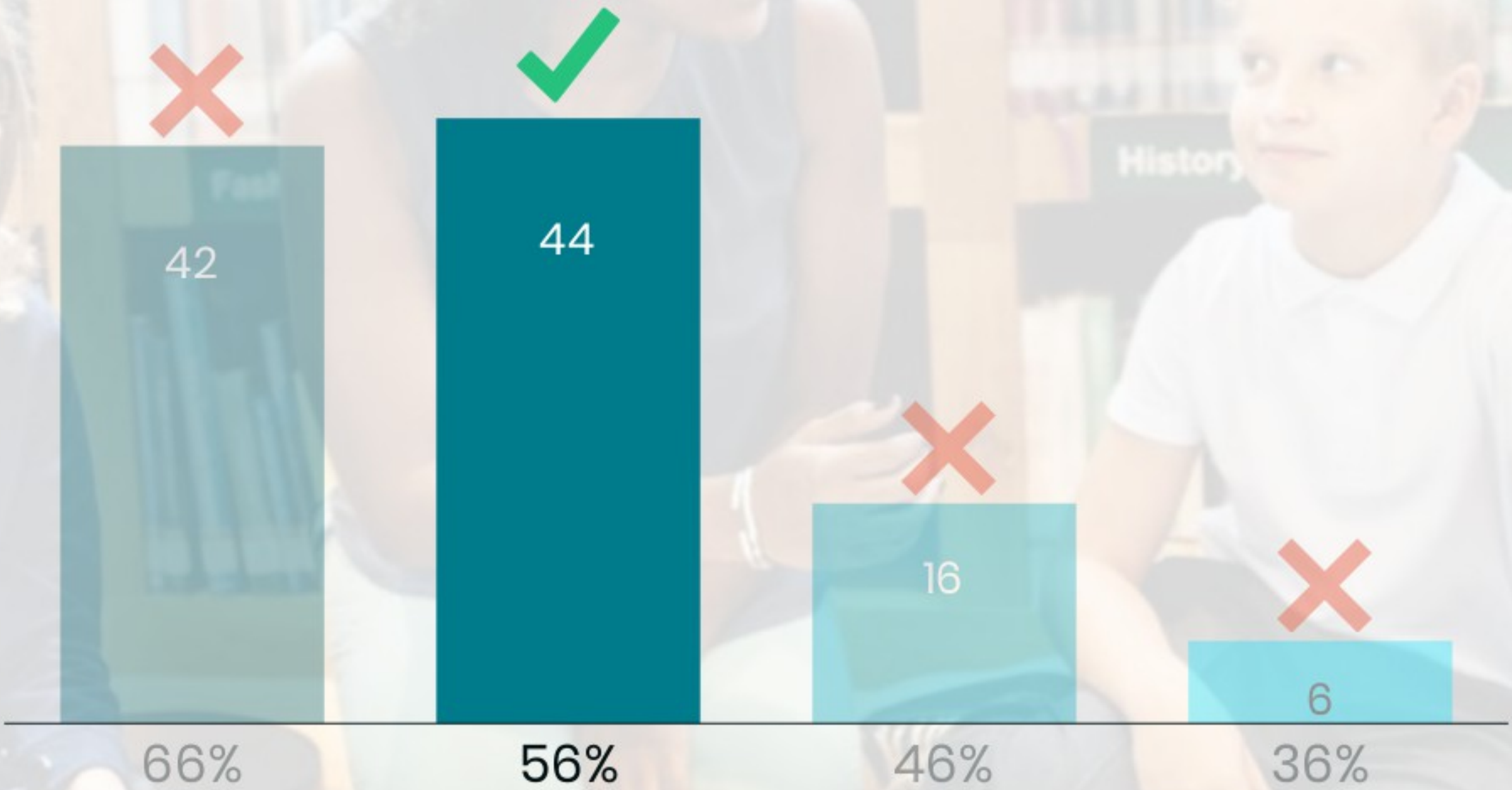
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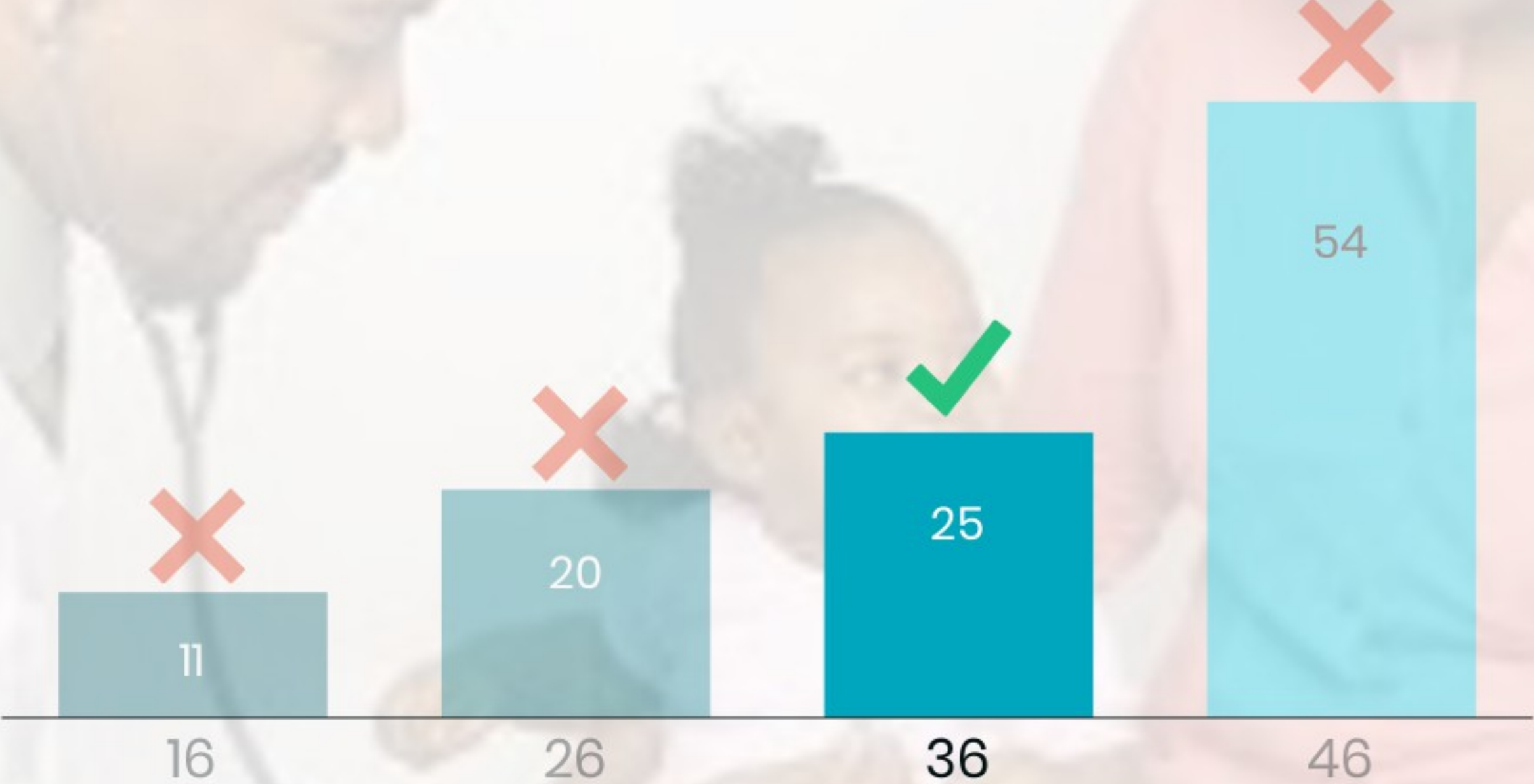
Approximately what percent of children with developmental delays are identified before the first day of kindergarten?



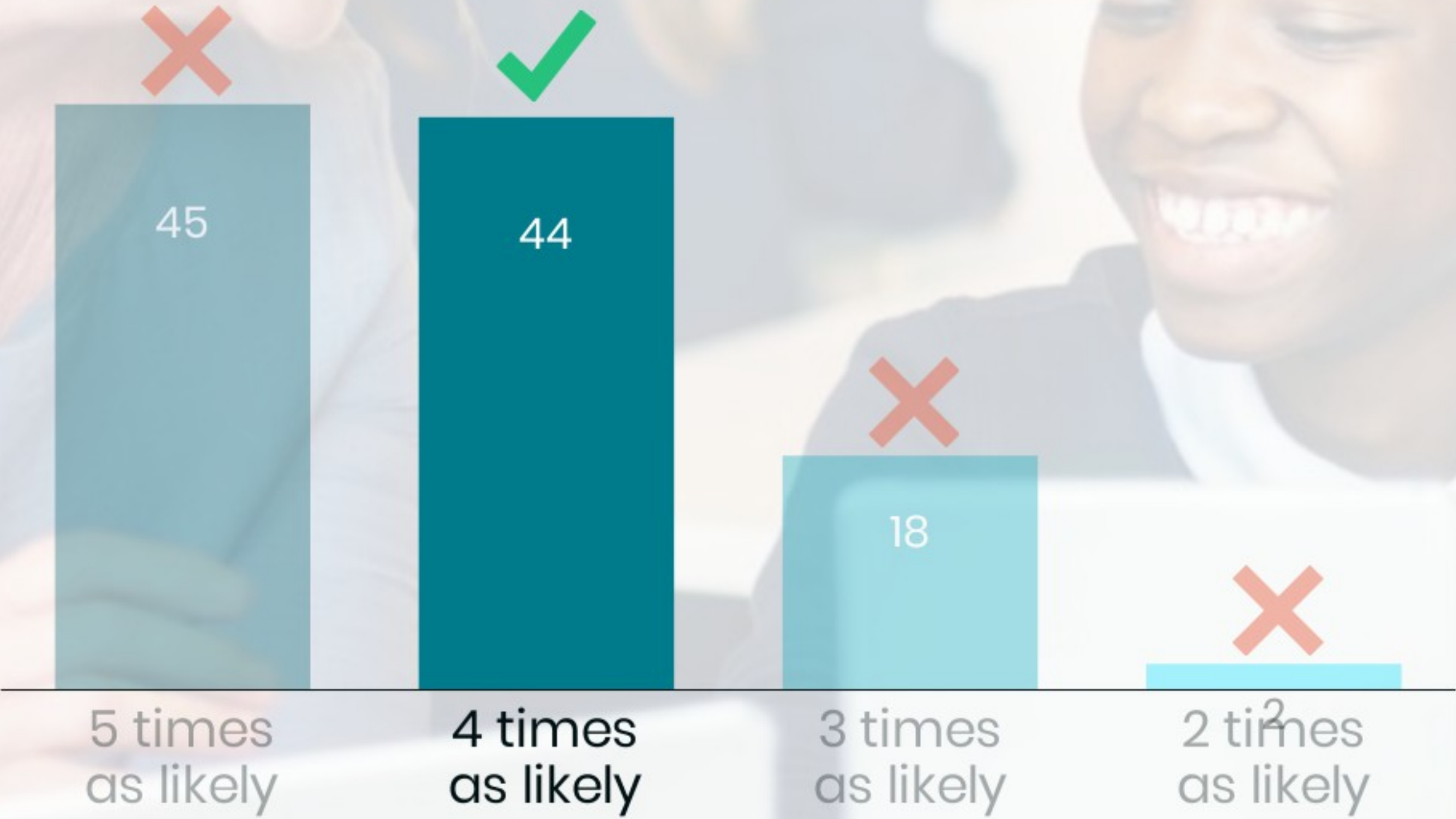
What percent of students in our public schools come from economically disadvantaged homes?



Out of 67 counties in Florida, where does Escambia County rank in overall health?



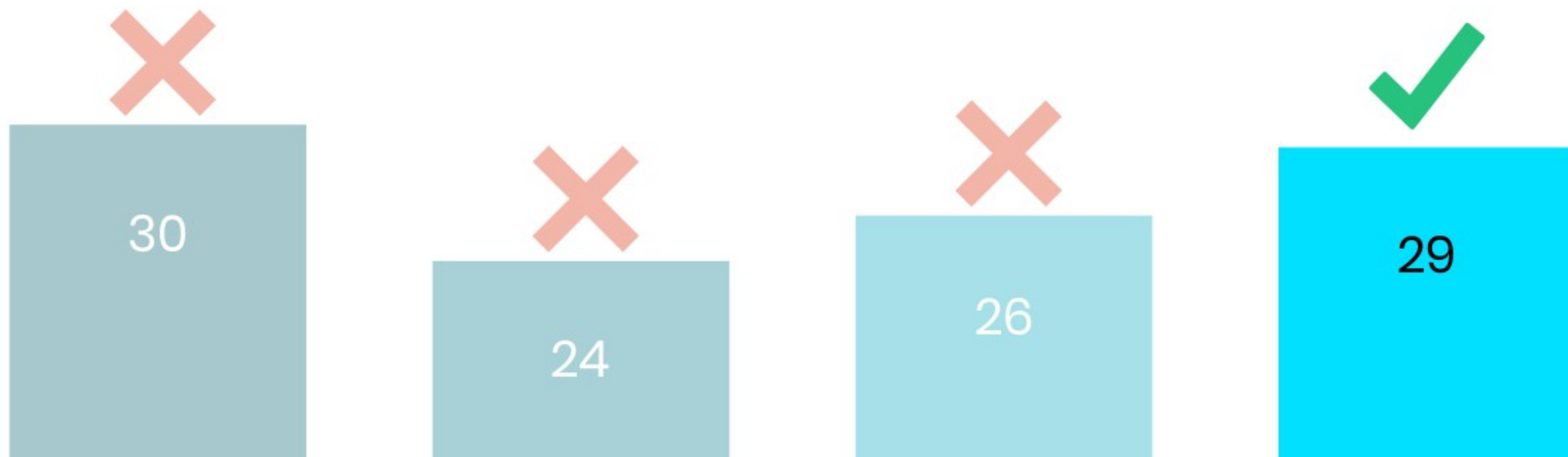
Research shows children ready for kindergarten are how many more times likely to graduate from college?

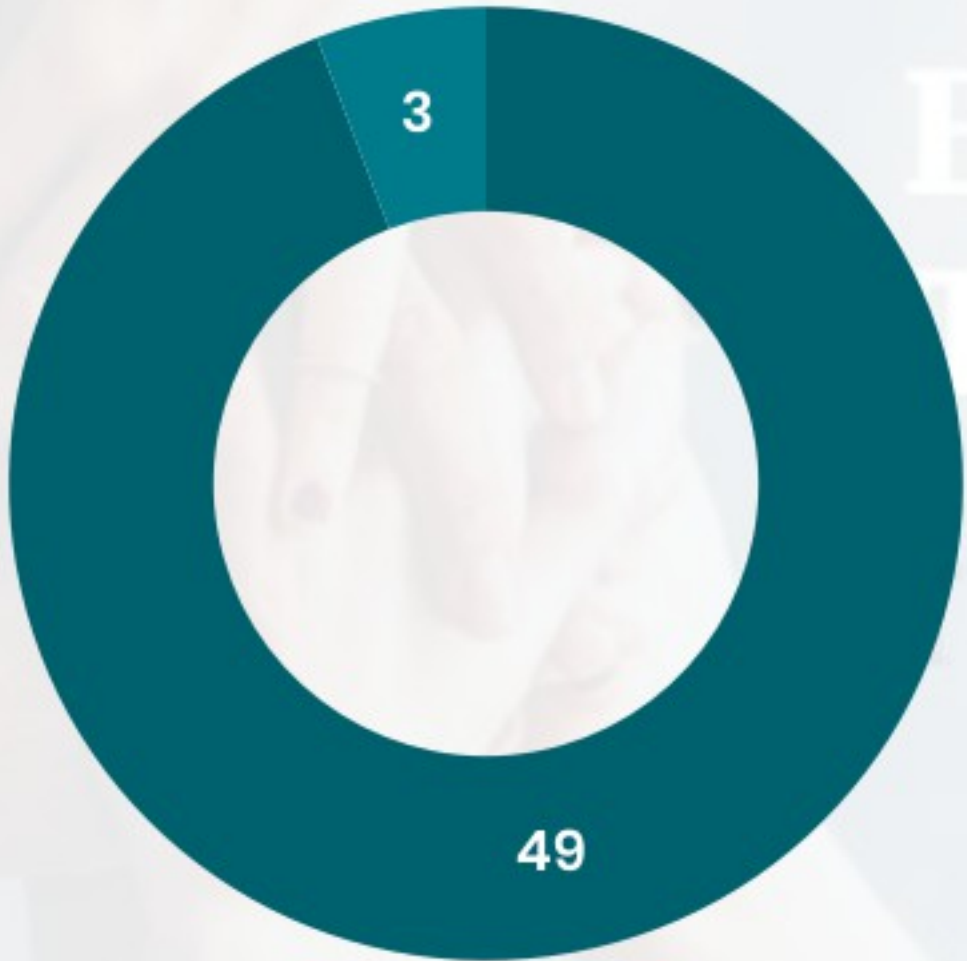
